

Editor's Notes : by Michele Guttenberger, MPM® HEALTHCARE.GOV FUTURE PM CASE STUDY IN LESSONS LEARNED

The launch of the Healthcare.gov website was an epic milestone of enormous Project Management failure. It will be the fodder for future Lesson Learned PM case studies. There were so many gaps in core project management principles that only a paradoxical miracle could have pulled off its success. Unfortunately, a miracle did not take place. Instead, we watched on as the U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services Kathleen Sebelius testified before a House Energy and Commerce Committee hearing on the failures of the site.

The success of the website was contingent on the synergy of government and private enterprise program deliverables' to a diverse stakeholder arena. It was a site with a multitude of integrated functional capabilities to: validate an individual's identity, legal residence, and income; record the individual's data; match it to eligible health insurance options; calculate and quantify any eligible subsidy; display comparison plans by costs and features; and lastly finalize the enrollment plan. This one stop shop and enroll website was an enormous technical undertaking in and of itself regardless of the powerful resistance in play and the political interventions to malign it.

The design and implementation failures of Healthcare.gov could be marked too to a conflict in two opposing software development ideologies. The biggest problem being - the Federal Government does not work under an agile environment. Federal Government is entrenched in a legacy IT mindset that demands development to accommodate and coordinate through these pillars of rigid protocols reined in with the dictates of traditional Government schedulers. This old forced fit model for delivering state-of-the-art services over the web was doomed to fail because it needed to emerge from an agile software development environment.

It was the elephant trying to dance to new maneuvers and partners left procedually clueless to the routines needed for this new dance number.
