PROJECT HISTORY OF NYC'S
HOLIDAY LIGHTING

New York City is known throughout the world for its hallmark holiday lighting whether it's the tree lighting at Rockefeller Center, the electrifying department store displays of Fifth Ave or the New Year's crystal ball at Times Square. But, who masterminded the first plans and the first marketing concept to package this technology into a grand NYC hallmark tradition? It was New Jersey that brought the Holiday Lights to NYC Fifth Avenue. To be specific, it was Harrison, New Jersey and Edison's General Electric Company that would supply the lights and equipment.

In 1882 at the Manhattan address of 139 East Thirty-Sixth-Street, the family home of Mr. E. H. Johnson, (President of the Edison Company for Electric Lighting) became the first electric lighted Christmas Tree to make its debut. Johnson lived in one of the first sections of the city to be wired for electricity. New York City became the modern world's Happy Holiday trendsetters because they were only a short distance away from Thomas Edison's electrical supply factories, its design engineers and a marketing department to target the sales brochures to the privileged homes and grand department stores. New York coveted these holiday marvels from Edison's lighting company. Big department stores knew these lighted trees attracted shoppers in droves. However, these gleaming inventions came with a Fifth Avenue price tag to match. The NYC Department store tree lights of the early 1900s had a price tag of \$300+. This is an equivalent of approximately \$6,517.75 today. But, the price was a complete package deal that included wiring services and a generator. Edison also realized that many would not make such an investment for a seasonal shopping attraction and his company also had rental plans for Christmas tree lights during this big shopping season.

Edison's General Electric Company provided the technology, design, marketing, distribution, set-up and electrical connection services and rental and payment plans to make New York City the world's new technological lighting spectacle for the Holidays.
